Wake Forest University is very pleased to invite you to make an official visit to our campus to evaluate our academic and athletics programs. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the expectations that we have for you, the coaches and student-athletes involved in your visit to Winston-Salem.

We want this visit to be a positive and rewarding experience for you. We expect our staff, coaches and student-athletes to conduct themselves in a manner that brings honor to the University and the athletic programs that we represent. It is expected that you, as a prospective member of this program, will follow the same rules and code of conduct while you are visiting with us. While you are visiting with us, a member of the coaching staff will accompany you and a current student-athlete may serve as your host.

As a member of the NCAA and Atlantic Coast Conference, Wake Forest University expects its prospective student-athletes and their hosts to adhere to the following rules:

- No use of alcohol;
- No use of drugs;
- No gambling/gaming activities;
- No activity that violates criminal law;
- Do not engage in any activity or attend any function that may cause a perception of impropriety;
- Do not engage in any activity that would bring harm to you or the reputation of Wake Forest University and/or the Athletics Program.

Meals, lodging and appropriate entertainment, arranged by our department staff, can be provided to you and up to four family members. Should an individual beyond the four family members accompany you on your visit, they will be required to pay any expenses (e.g. meals, lodging, entertainment) at the time the expense is incurred. In addition, NCAA regulations permit a maximum of five expense paid visits and no more than one to each institution.

Our coaching staff recruits prospective student-athletes of character and integrity. Please know that this is one of the reasons Wake Forest University has selected you to make a visit to our campus and we all look forward to meeting you and seeing you exhibit these commendable attributes while you are here with us. If you experience any problems or have any questions or concerns while you are visiting, please do not hesitate to contact us. We look forward to seeing you and hope that you will enjoy your visit to Wake Forest University.
