Subject: 2019 Spring/Summer Camps—Athletic Trainer Requirements & Compensation

The time has come again to prepare for summer camps. The Sports Medicine Department will again be available to coordinate medical coverage for your camps this summer provided arrangements are made in advance.

As was effective last year, for improved safety you will need at least one athletic trainer per 100 participants. In addition, you must also have at least one athletic trainer per camp site (ie. Sutton and Miller or Spry and Water Tower). Please keep this as a reference when you receive the confirmation email from me with number of ATC's needed and expected salary.

Camp directors, please return this form by March 1. Please complete this form even if you do not require athletic training services. When sending the completed form, please include a camp schedule so I can calculate appropriate salary. The fees for your medical coverage are listed below. If your camp does not fall within the guidelines please call me to discuss payment.
